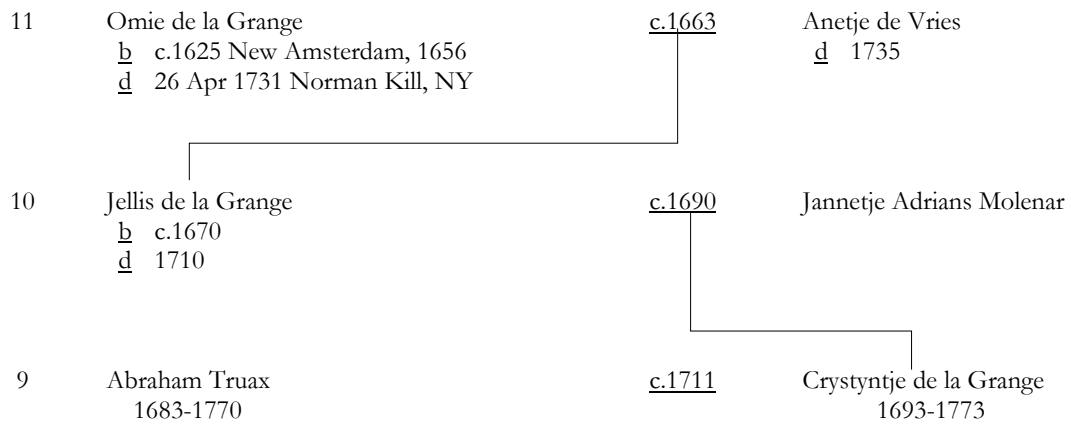

DE LA GRANGE

The ancestry of Christina de la Grange, wife of Abraham Truax (see Truax Pedigree No. 2, Ancestor Generation No. 9) has been traced to her grandfather, immigrant ancestor Omie de la Grange. Information for this ancestry was supplied by Mrs. Elizabeth M. Ellis Hamberger of Fredericksburg, Va, and printed as a footnote to the entry for Abraham Truax in the *N.Y. Genealogical and Biographical Record* (58:78).

Omie de la Grange¹¹ (c.1625-1731)

Omie de la Grange¹¹ was born around 1625 and came to New Amsterdam in 1656. He was in Albany in 1666; and he later moved to Norman Kill, where he was buried 26 Apr 1731 at about the age of 106 years (see De La Grange Pedigree). About 1663 he married Annetje de Vries, who died in 1735.

His name suggests that he may have been a Walloon, or French emigre, while her name suggests some Dutchification in a Walloon family (Annetje = Dutch, de Vries = French). Possibly, Annetje was born in New Amsterdam of Walloon parents.

- i. Johannes, b 1664-65 at Albany; m 28 Sep 1697 at New York Eytie Croesvert; d 6 May 1743; buried in the old Van Buskerk burying ground at Constable's Hook, N.J. (58:78, 272).
- + ii. **Jellies**, b about 1670.
- iii. Omie, b about 1672; m 28 Mar 1697 at Albany Elsie van Loon; d 22 Jan 1724.
- iv. Annetje, b about 1675; m (banns) 19 May 1700 at Kingston Arie Molenaar; d July 1761.
- v. Christiaan.
- vi. Isaac, bap 28 Apr 1686 at Albany; m (banns) 6 Apr 1722 (Lutheran Records) Marie Burchard.
- vii. Christiana, bap 10 Oct 1688 at Albany.
- viii. Jacobus, bap 23 Apr 1692 at Albany; m 24 Oct 1717 Engeltie Veeder, dau., Johannes Veeder, both of Norman Kill.

Jellis de la Grange¹⁰ (c.1670-1710)

Jellis de la Grange,¹⁰ born about 1670 (probably at Albany), married about 1690 Jannetje Adrians Molenaar. He died in 1710.

That Jellis was the son of Omie de la Grange is attested by his identification as such in the indenture of apprenticeship of Jellis to Cornelis van Schelluyne, 30 Oct 1682 (*Early Records of Albany*, Vol. 3, p. 544).

- + i. **Chrystyntje** (Christina), b 20 Sep 1693 at Albany; bap 24 Sep 1693; m Abraham Truax.
- ii. Elizabeth, bap 6 Oct 1695 at Albany.
- iii. Anna, bap 29 Dec 1700 at Schenectady.
- iv. Christian, bap 25 July 1703 at Albany; m about 1727 Catalyntje Dumont, bap 22 Jan 1709, only child of Peter Dumont and his second wife Catalyntje Rapalje. Had four children, bap at Harlingen, N.J.
